Kitchen Drainage Guide for Sewerage and Living



Drainpipes are not that strong against heat. Please chill the water before pouring it down the drain.

The rigid polyvinyl chloride (RPVC) pipes primarily used for domestic wastewater pipes do not handle heat well.

When dumping boiling water down the drain after cooking, make sure to do so with tap water running, or wait until the hot water cools down (roughly 45°C or less).
