



## Try using a rubber cup plunger.

First use rubber gloves to directly remove any visible obstruction from the toilet drain, then try using a commercially available rubber-cup plunger.

Using more toilet paper than is necessary can cause your toilet to clog. In addition, you cannot flush anything other than waste and toilet paper down the toilet.

Do not flush disposable diapers, water-insoluble tissues, plastic, etc. down the toilet.
