



**Can I put glass or plastic bottles inside the toilet tank to reduce water consumption?**



**Doing so may cause the drainage pipes to become blocked. Please do not put glass or plastic bottles in the toilet tank.**

Each toilet is designed to use its own best amount of water to effectively carry waste to the sewage pipes. Purposefully reducing water flow may lead the drain-pipes to clog, incurring cleaning fees. Please do not put glass or plastic bottles in the toilet tank.

Currently, water-saving toilets and other such devices are increasing.
