



Can I put glass or plastic bottles inside the toilet tank to reduce water consumption?



Doing so may cause the drainage pipes to become blocked. Please do not put glass or plastic bottles in the toilet tank.

Each toilet is designed to use its own best amount of water to effectively carry waste to the sewage pipes. Purposefully reducing water flow may lead the drain-pipes to clog, incurring cleaning fees. Please do not put glass or plastic bottles in the toilet tank.

Currently, water-saving toilets and other such devices are increasing.
